


## Nonprofit Management Using Dimensions

- Entity and GL Accounts are essential
- Sites, Programs, and Restrictions are tagged independently
- Donor, Vendor, and Employee tagged on transactions by default
- Grants & Projects can be tied to Donor, with default Program/Restriction

### **Automated Release from Restriction**


As qualified expenses are incurred on a grant or project, Sage Intacct can release the matching revenue from restricted into unrestricted funds.






GL Outlier Detection scores outliers using machine learning to call attention to what requires a closer look during the GL approval process



## General Ledger Outlier Assistant


- GL Outlier Assistant can now be enabled for GL Entry and Approvals


## What is Spend Management?

- Sage Intacct allows you to validate transactions against a budget, period, and dimensions
- Offers warning or hard stop for transactions exceeding budget amount
- Validation available in:
  - Purchasing (even before a posting-type transaction occurs)
  - Accounts Payable
  - General Ledger
- Ability to include "committed expenses" or encumbrances

### **M&E and Outcome Metrics**

#### **INDICATOR**

Percentage of Grade 6 primary students continuing to high school

#### **DEFINITION**

 Number of students who start the first day of Grade 7, divided by the total number of Grade 6 students the previous year, multiplied by 100.

#### **SAMPLE CALCULATION:**

80 Students start first day of Grade 7 in Sept 2021

X 100 = 45.7%

175 Grade 6 Students in June 2021

### M&E and Outcome Metrics 45.7%

#### **INDICATOR**

Percentage of Grade 6 primary students continuing to high school

#### **DEFINITION**

 Number of students who start the first day of Grade 7, divided by the total number of Grade 6 students the previous year, multiplied by 100.

#### **SAMPLE CALCULATION:**

80 Students start first day of Grade 7 in Sept 2021

175 Grade 6 Students in June 2021

**X** 100 = 45.7%


